



Abellon wins Energy Globe Award 2015 for INDIA

We are delighted to share that Abellon has notched up one more global recognition, having been declared as the National Winner in India, of the Energy Globe Awards 2015.

Initiated in 1999, the Energy Globe Award is one of the world's most prestigious Environment Awards, given annually to outstanding projects focusing on energy efficiency, renewable energies and conservation of resources. The vision behind the Award is to honour projects that make a contribution to conserving resources, improving air and water quality, energy efficiency, renewable energy and creates awareness in these areas. The award is supported by globally recognized and respected names such as Mr. Mikhail Gorbachev, Kofi Annan, as well as the EU Parliament and the EU Commission.

The national ENERGY GLOBE Awards distinguish sustainable best project submissions of a country, and Abellon was selected as the National Winner for India from amongst 60 entries, which were judged by an eminent jury, chaired by Ms. Maneka Gandhi, Member of Parliament and noted Environmentalist.

Winners of the national award round, which sees competition from 161 countries, further compete for the global award.

The award covers five categories: Earth, Fire, Water, Air, and Youth. We applied in the Fire category, and the subject of our application was **"Prevention of Agricultural Residue Burning for Environment Protection & Energy Generation: An Innovative Biomass Collection Model"**
